# **Speech Outline**

**Purpose:** Write out purpose of speech. Keynotes inspire; Training sessions inform.

**Opening:** Your opening can include a joke, shocking question, anecdote and/or startling fact, Scripture, poem, quote. It should state purpose of article to which your points will be related.

**Point 1:** All points need to relate to purpose. Each point contain some of the following: anecdote, startling fact, humor, Scripture, poem and or quote.
