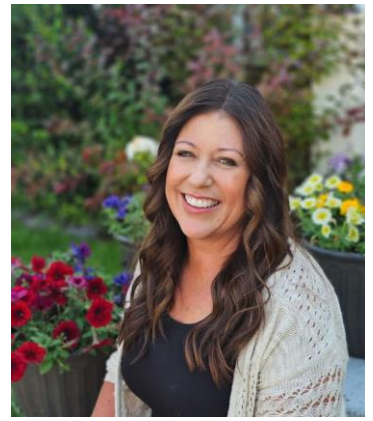


Name: Joy Bennett
