He just wants to be left alone and doesn't like to rock the boat. But that's just what happens when his retired FBI agent father on his deathbed asks Rory to hand deliver a sealed letter to the Las Vegas Sheriff's department which details plans by a new Muslim Mafia running the casinos to destroy the city with an underground nuclear bomb. Rory tries to run from his dad's request to warn Vegas of its impending doom by jumping on a cruise ship instead, only to find himself entangled in a series of mishaps including being imprisoned on a submarine. Full of intrigue, suspense and a little romance, The Runaway Prophet delivers the message that you can try to run from God's call, but you can't hide—and that sometimes by rescuing other people, God rescues you in the process.

My manuscript for *The Runaway Prophet* is complete (69,390 words) and ready in its entirety for your review. It is considered "edgy" inspirational fiction would appeal to a universal audience. I am also the author of two other inspirational novels, *The Faithful One* and *The Peace Maker* (published by Ellechor Publishing House, a small Christian publisher) which have both received rave reviews and sold thousands of copies.
