Ingredients of a Good Query Letter

• Brief — usually one page.

• First paragraph is an attention-grabber. Can be the opening paragraph of your manuscript.

• Explains what you want to write, why you want to write it, how you're going to write it, and how it will benefit the magazine's readers — why it's a good fit. Ties in with a specific theme.

• States your qualifications for writing/related experience, background, and any published works.

• Clarifies any particulars: word length, deadline, etc.
